PICO Console

Central Management Software



The PICO Console is a server based application aimed at providing control of all PICOfreedoms within an organisation. As it is a server based application this needs to be run on a Windows Server, with Certificate Authority, SQL Server database and Internet Information Services (IIS).

The concept of the PICO Console is to provide full management of all PICOfreedoms from a central console including:

Allocation of PICOfreedom units to individuals
an individual may have multiple units, but a PICOfreedom can only have one owner.

Backup and restoration of PICOfreedoms
define whether a device needs to be backed up in number of uses or number of days.

Control of PICOfreedom usage
i.e. on internal computers only, external computers only, any computer. There are also controls to disable a device if it is not connected to server within a certain period.

Auto-updates
Allocate files and applications centrally through auto-updating.

Manual disabling/enabling of PICOfreedom
a unit may become disabled due to not meeting console settings, i.e. is not connected within configured time frame or too many incorrect password attempts.

Password configuration
control the password length, password age and number of attempts at login.

Deactivation and reactivation of a PICOfreedom
this differs from disabling a unit as data is deleted when a deactivation occurs.

Synchronisation
with Active Directory domains and users for ease of management, and prioritise domains and users accordingly.

Auditing
of read/write and deletion of files through an event log.

Reporting based on PICOfreedom usage
through predefined or customisable reports and charts.
