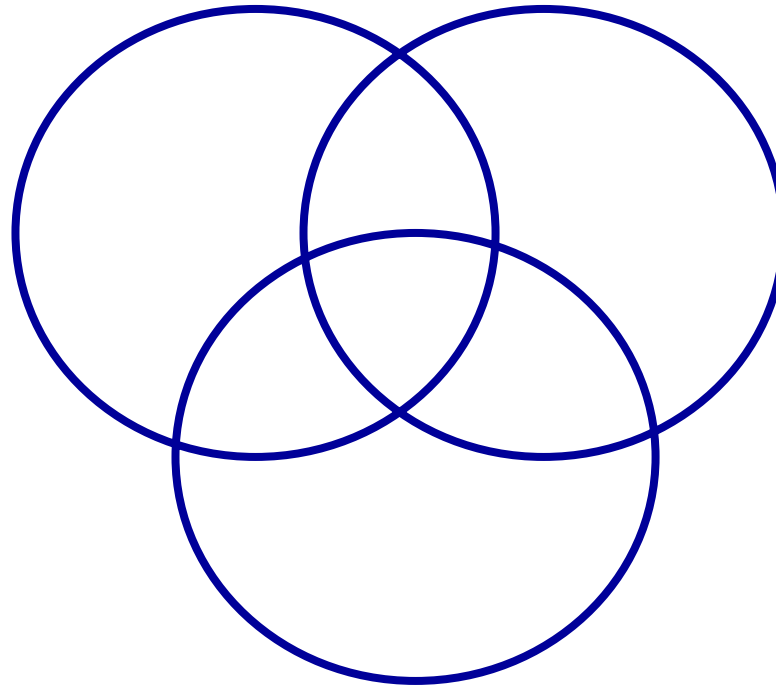

**Operability = Functionality + Availability + Performance + Ease of Use**

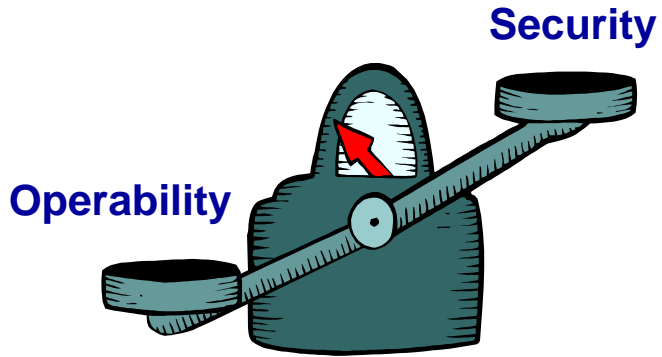

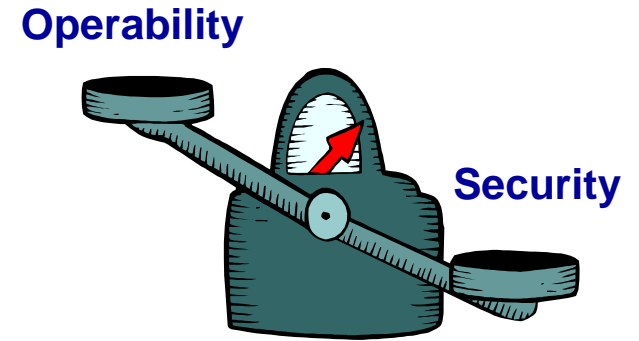
**Security = Confidentiality + Integrity + Availability**

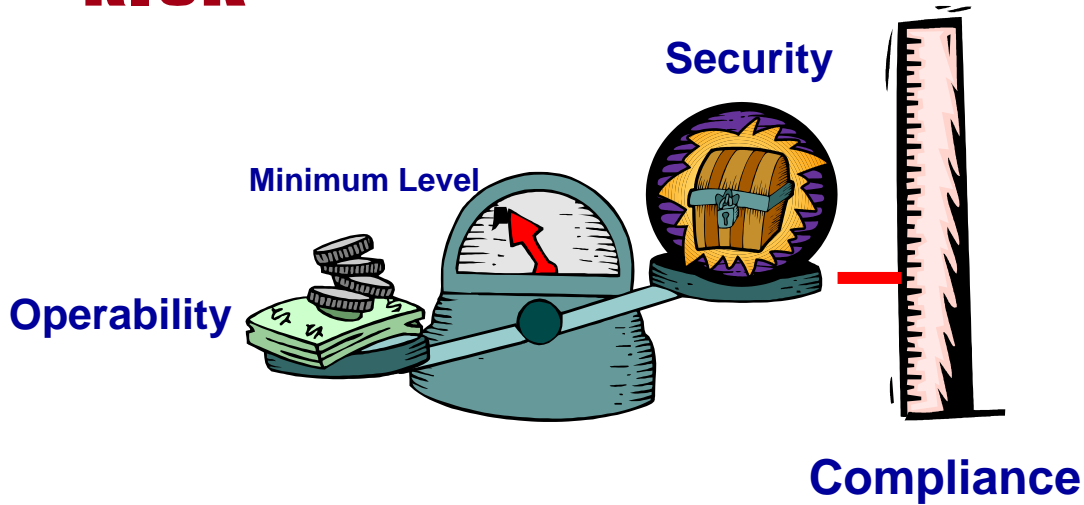

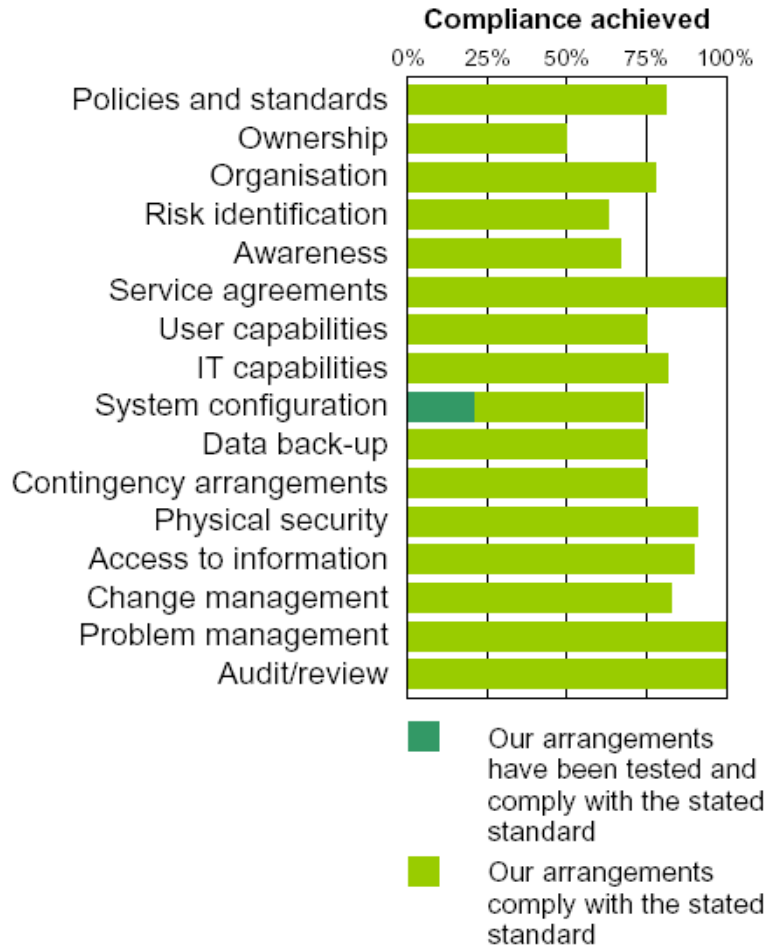


**HIGH RISK**
